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## FAMILY COVENANT

Carolina Christian School is dedicated to providing a quality education based on the Gospel of Jesus Christ. The Gospel, as taught in the inerrant scriptures, is not just part of our curriculum but it is the foundation of our curriculum. It is our firm conviction that an education institution founding its academic philosophy on the Gospel will produce an academic program far superior to anything the world can produce. We also believe that children, young men and young women whose minds have been set free by God's saving grace, will excel spiritually and academically to the level that God has uniquely created for each one of them. CCS seeks to enroll families firmly committed to a lifestyle which exemplifies a personal relationship with Jesus Christ and who are serious about educating their children in a Biblical worldview.

With that in mind, please carefully read the following:

1. I understand that my child(ren) will be taught that salvation and a relationship with God comes only through individual faith in the person and work of Jesus Christ. CCS students will be instructed, encouraged, and expected to live for Christ in every aspect of daily life (thought, word and deed).
2. I understand that my child(ren) will be encouraged to participate regularly in Bible reading, study and prayer, and I am committed to making weekly worship and Biblical instruction in a local church body a vital part of my family's life.
3. I agree with and am committed to supporting the purposes, policies, and procedures of CCS. This includes the spiritual, moral, academic, dress and discipline standards set forth in the parent/student handbook.
4. I understand that home and school must work together in our common goal and that communication will be a vital aspect to the success of the school year.
5. I understand that CCS has full discretion in the discipline of my child(ren) within the bounds of the discipline policy set forth in the student handbook.
6. I agree to allow my child to participate in all required field trips and school activities during the school year.
7. I agree to support the school to the best of my ability, in faithful prayer for the administration, faculty and student body, and in offering practical help and resources to the school.
8. I understand the need for unity and agree to demonstrate only that which is positive and that which would promote a bond of unity and peace. I agree and am committed to the resolution of all problems according to Biblical principles.
9. I understand that enrollment at Carolina Christian is a privilege and not a right. I understand that CCS reserves the right to refuse any application at any time if it is determined by the school administration that the student is not suited to the program offered by the school. CCS reserves the right to dismiss any student whose academic performance or spiritual and moral conduct does not meet the standards expressed in the student handbook.
10. I understand that my child's application will not be considered until all required forms are submitted and the application fee is paid. Further, enrollment in a class is contingent upon all fees being paid in a timely manner.
11. I understand that once my child is accepted, I am committed to CCS payment of tuition and fees for a **full academic year**, and that all fees (book fees, tuition and registration) are non-refundable. Further, I agree to the timely payment of all tuition and fees for the academic year. I understand that late fees and NSF fees will apply, and that if my account is 60 days delinquent, I may be asked to remove my student from the school. I understand that CCS will not release any student records until accounts are paid in full.

## TUITION ASSISTANCE

Carolina Christian School offers financial aid to families who demonstrate the need as long as funds are available. Tuition assistance applications may be obtained from the school office and will be considered only after a student has been accepted for admission; therefore, early application is important.

# FINANCIAL INFORMATION

When a child enrolls at Carolina Christian, a place is reserved for the entire school year and parents contract for an entire year of tuition. The school budget is set accordingly. Parents are requested to make every effort to complete each semester before changes in schools or communities are made. New students will be charged for the entire month when they are first enrolled. **Records are released to pupils, parents, or other schools only when the student's account is paid in full.**

## Tuition Payment Options

Tuition may be paid by one of the following plans:

1. **By the year** - The entire year's bill is paid by July 1 (5% discount if paid by July 1).
2. **Two (2) semi-annual payments** - July 1, and January 1.
3. **Ten (10) monthly payments** - July through April.
4. **Twelve (12) monthly payments** - July through June.
5. **Four (4) quarterly payments** - July 1, October 1, January 1, April 1.

No student will be allowed to begin school until all fees are paid.

Payments are due on the first of each month.

Late fees of \$30.00 are assessed to accounts not paid by the 10th of each month.

Fees for returned checks are uncollectible credit/debit card payments are \$35.00.

## \*Carolina Christian School's Volunteer Hours Fee Policy:

In an attempt to offset the rising cost of educational fees, CCS has adopted a volunteer program. We do our very best to keep tuition affordable for all families. For this reason, we are requiring families to either pay a \$25.00 per month fee (\$250 year) or invest 25 hours per school year in the school. *Areas of service include assisting in class, organizing or working an extra-curricular activity, or coaching. There are many other areas of service, talk with office staff or Parent Teacher Fellowship Leader for more information. We are partners with you on behalf of your child and need your involvement. Thank you for your participation.*

**Note:** While tuition is prorated on a monthly basis for students entering or leaving during the year, all fees are payable in full and are non-refundable.

# Extended Early Morning Care and After Care

(This form must be on file for all students K-5 through 12)

Early morning care and after school care are offered for all students, K-5 through 12th grade. Students arriving on campus before school, or remaining on campus after school, are required to be supervised. Your student will be charged according to the fee schedule below. The only exception to this is if a student is a member of an athletic team and is staying on campus until their practice begins. Students waiting for practice will not be charged; however, they must remain in aftercare in a supervised capacity. No student, including high school students, is to be on campus before or after school unless they are in a supervised activity. Students may attend games on their own, provided a written note of parental permission is brought on the day of the game. We understand that high school students are responsible and may not feel the need for supervision, however; if they are on campus, we are accountable for their safety. Therefore, high school students must attend early morning care and/or aftercare if on campus.

Early Morning Care is charged at a daily rate of \$1.00 per day per session. Sessions are as follows:

Early Morning Care: Kindergarten - 12th Grade 7:30 am - 8:15 am (charges begin at 7am).

Aftercare is charged at a monthly rate of \$150.00 per month per session, or \$11.00 per day, per session. Whichever is less. Sessions are as follows:

Kindergarten - 5th Grade: 3:15 to 5:30 pm (charges begin at 3:30 pm)

Grades 6 - 12: 3:15 to 5:30 pm (charges begin at 3:30 pm)

An additional charge of \$2.00 will be assessed if your student is picked up from 5:30-6:00 pm, and an additional \$5.00 charge will be assessed if you pick up your student after 6:00 pm.

Early morning care and aftercare charges will be billed monthly and must be paid by the 10th of each month in order for your child to remain in the program. Students will not be allowed to stay with unpaid charges.
